

Road Improvement Priority List

On May 15, 2008 the Craig City Council adopted the following Road Improvement Priority List.

1. Beach Road (from 7th Street to 1st Street)
2. Seventh Street (connects Water Street to Beach Road)
3. First Street (connects Main Street to Beach Road)
4. West Hamilton Drive
5. East Hamilton Drive – Public Works has stated that a portion of the existing waterline between Windy Way and the CK Highway needs to be replaced, this section of buried utility line was included as an additive alternative to the recent contract to replace the water main along the Craig Klawock Highway that was awarded to SNS Construction.
6. Cold Storage Road (from Craig Klawock Highway to COHO trailers) – The safety issue can be resolved by extending the pavement at the intersection of Cold Storage Road and the CK Highway to the COHO trailers and installing a crosswalk.
7. Hilltop Drive (from the Craig Klawock Highway 200' north) – The vertical curve at the point approximately 200' north of the Craig Klawock Highway should be reduced if possible. *This road is included in CCA's list of IRR funded roads
8. JT Brown Street (from the Craig Klawock Highway to the stream crossing at the entrance to the industrial park).
9. Cedar Street
10. Cold Storage Road (from COHO trailers to EC Phillips property line)
11. Fifth Street
12. Main Street
13. Port Bagial Boulevard *This road is included in CCA's list of IRR funded roads
14. Second Street
15. Sixth Street
16. Spruce Street
17. Water Tower Road. *This road is included in CCA's list of IRR funded roads
18. Ninth Street
19. Third Street (from Spruce Street to Beach Road)
20. Sunnyside Drive
21. Cove Street
22. Fourth Street (from Spruce Street to Beach Road)
23. Eighth Street
24. Tanner Crab Court. *This road is included in CCA's list of IRR funded roads. The identified CCA project includes the access and parking area at the high school ballpark.
25. Achten Court
26. Cemetery Island Road
27. Oceanview Dr.
28. Ptarmigan Court
29. Sunnahae Court
30. T&H Street. *This road is included in CCA's list of IRR funded roads
31. Fourth Street (from Main Street to Water Street)
32. Brandi Court

34. Kelsey Court. *This road is included in CCA's list of IRR funded roads
35. Night Court
36. North Hamilton Dr.
37. Park Place
38. Part Way
39. Thomas Court
40. School Road – Was not scored since there is no ROW/Easement dedicated for the road.
*This road is included in CCA's list of IRR funded roads
41. JS Street – Was not scored since there is no ROW/Easement for the section between Tract 5 and Tract 17, USS 2611
42. Windy Way – Was not scored since ½ of the ROW (Tract 18, USS 2611) has not been dedicated.

Notes:

1. Hilltop Drive, Water Tower Road, School Road, Kelsey Court, T&H Street, Tanner Crab Court (including access to the high school ballpark and the ballpark parking lot), Port Bagial Boulevard and the CCA Parking Lot have been identified by the Craig Community Association for paving using available Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) money. The city will work with CCA in the design, engineering and construction of these roads. The IRR identified roads have been included in the priority list, but will be paved based on CCA priorities with IRR funds.
2. Road improvements along areas that currently have separated bike or walking trails should not negatively impact or reduce pedestrian and bicycle access to those paths.
