TERMS OF MOORAGE

- 1) All vessels moored in City of Craig’s harbors are required to be seaworthy and operational at all times.
- 2) Moorage for said vessel shall be paid in advance. Invoices for permanent moorage will be sent October 1st of each year and are due within 30 days.
- 3) Vessel owners with unpaid moorage that becomes 60 days or more past due shall lose the privilege of mooring any vessel in the City of Craig’s harbors and will be subject to being cited and/or having their vessel impounded until all moorage, citations and impound fees have been paid. Permanent stall holders will forfeit their stall if moorage is not paid within 60 days.
- 4) Electrical usage for permanent stall holders is paid directly to the local power company, AP& T. If your stall will be vacant for an extended period we ask that you disconnect your power service. The Harbor Staff cannot always prevent others from using your electricity.
- 5) There are no refunds for vacating a stall prior to the end of the annual period.
- 6) If you sell your vessel, neither the stall nor the paid moorage goes with the vessel sale. The owner must notify the harbor office within 7 days of selling a vessel. The stall holder has 4 months to replace the vessel with a vessel of the same size range. If the stall remains unoccupied for a full year, the harbor reserves the right to assign the stall to someone on the wait list.
