

**CITY OF CRAIG
RESOLUTION 17-03**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ALTERNATIVE ALLOCATION METHOD FOR THE
FY17 SHARED FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT
THIS ALLOCATION METHOD FAIRLY REPRESENTS THE DISTRIBUTION OF
SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS OF FISHERIES BUSINESS ACTIVITY IN FMA 19:
SOUTHERN SOUTHEAST**

WHEREAS, AS29.60.450 requires that for a municipality to participate in the FY17 Shared Fisheries Business Tax Program, the municipality must demonstrate to the Department of Commerce that the municipality suffered significant effects during calendar year 2015 from fisheries business activities; and,

WHEREAS, 3 AAC 134.060 provides for the allocation of available program funding to eligible municipalities located within fisheries management areas specified by the Department of Commerce; and,

WHEREAS, 3AAC 134.070 provides for the use, at the discretion of the Department of Commerce, of alternative allocation methods which may be used within fisheries management areas if all eligible municipalities within the area agree to use the method, and the method incorporates some measure of the relative significant effect of fisheries business activity on the respective municipalities in the area; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Craig proposes to use an alternative allocation method for allocation of FY17 funding available within the Southern Southeast in agreement with all other municipalities in this area participating in the FY16 Shared Fisheries Business Tax Program;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City of Craig by this resolution certifies that the following alternative allocation method fairly represents the distribution of significant effect during 2015 of fisheries business activity in the Southern Southeast Fisheries Management Area.
