CITY OF CRAIG RESOLUTION NO. 19-19

DECLARING INTENT TO REIMBURSE HARBOR PROJECT EXPENSES WITH PROCEEDS FROM A DEBT OBLIGATION

WHEREAS, the City of Craig plans to construct a harbor on city-owned tidelands; and

WHEREAS, construction of the harbor may require financing through loans and/or issuance of tax exempt municipal bonds; and,

WHEREAS, construction of the harbor may require financing through grants; and,

WHEREAS, the city council wishes to ensure that initial project costs incurred prior to final approval of loan and/or issuance of bonds, or receipt of grant funds, are reimbursable; and,

WHEREAS, project costs incurred prior to financing may be reimbursable to the city with the adaption of a reimbursement resolution by the city council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Craig city council adopts this reimbursement resolution related to costs incurred during development of what is commonly known as the downtown harbor project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution enables the city reimburse itself from subsequent loan/bond proceeds, and other grant-based or loan-based sources of capital, for certain expenses incurred in the design and construction of the downtown harbor project.
