

ORDINANCE NO. 324

CITY OF CRAIG

AMENDING SECTION 2.04.260 OF THE CRAIG MUNICIPAL CODE
WITH RESPECT TO CONTRACTUAL SERVICES PERFORMED BY THE CITY,
BY THE MAYOR OR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted hereby shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Action. This ordinance amends the Administration and Personnel Code Section 2.04.260 by adding the underlined words and deleting that which is in brackets [] in the following:

2.04.260 COMBINING OF OFFICES. No person shall serve simultaneously as mayor and as member of the council. A person appointed as acting mayor in the absence of the elected mayor shall serve as mayor and shall not serve as a member of the council during the absence of the elected mayor. Two or more administrative or appointive offices may be combined and a salary paid for each. Neither the mayor nor any member of the council shall serve in any administrative or appointive capacity [.] except that the council may contract with the mayor or a councilperson for contractual services for a limited period of time where the person holding office has skills or a background which make the person especially qualified to render the service contracted for. The council shall fix by ordinance the salaries of elected officers. Salaries of elected officers may not be reduced during a term of office. An elected officer may not receive any other compensation for service to the municipality. Per diem payments or reimbursements for expenses are not compensation under this section.
