

ORDINANCE NO. 359

CITY OF CRAIG

AMENDING TITLE 4 (BOAT HARBOR) BY ADDING
4.20.090 LOSS OF ASSIGNED RESERVED MOORAGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted hereby shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Action. This ordinance amends Title 4 (Boat Harbor) by adding the following:

4.20.090 Loss of Assigned Reserved Moorage. If the owner of a vessel to which a reserved slip or space has been assigned does not have the vessel in the slip or dry docked in Craig or use the reserved slip or space for which it is assigned for at least four months each assignment period, the reserved slip is forfeited.

However, the Harbormaster may waive this requirement for one year under exceptional circumstances such as extended ocean voyages, vessels under going repairs or other similar situations.

The decision of the Harbormaster may be referred to the Harbor Advisory Committee within 30 days. Final appeal will be to the City Council.
