

ORDINANCE NO. 362

CITY OF CRAIG

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 1992-93

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance and is not of a general and permanent nature and shall not become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Amendment No. 1

A residual equity transfer in the amount of \$110,000 from the General Fund to Fund 33 "Clark's Bay Dolphin" for the purpose of funding a new dolphin at the Clark's Bay Ferry Terminal.

Amendment No. 2

A residual equity transfer in the amount of \$150,000 from the General Fund to Notes Receivable "Craig Health Corporation" for the purpose of providing an operating loan to the Craig Health Corporation.

Section 4. Unexpended Balances. All unexpended balances shall lapse as of June 30, 1993

Section 5. Mill Levy. The rate of levy on each dollar of taxable property shall remain as previously set at six (6) mills
