

ORDINANCE 369

CITY OF CRAIG

REZONING ALL RESIDENTIALLY ZONED LOTS IN OLD CRAIG FROM RESIDENTIAL HIGH DENSITY TO RESIDENTIAL HIGH DENSITY-I

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Action. This ordinance amends the official zoning map by changing the zoning designation on the following lots from High Density Residential to High Density Residential-I:

Within USS 1430

- All lots within Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 12, 13, 16, 23, 24 and 28;
- Lots 1 through 4, inclusive, of Block 8;
- Lots 2 through 7, inclusive, of Block 11;
- Lots 1 and 2, Block 15;
- Lots 1 through 6, inclusive, of Block 17;
- Lots 1 through 3 and Lots 6 through 8, inclusive of Block 19;
- Lots 1, 2 and 3, of Block 20
- Lots 1 through 4 and Lots 6 through 8, inclusive, of Block 21;
- Lots 2, 3 and 4 of Block 22;
- Lot 1, Block 23A.

Within Craig Tideland Addition:

- All lots within Blocks 4A, 5A, 6A and 17A.
- Lots 3 and 4 of Block 3A.
