

ORDINANCE NO. 95-406

CITY OF CRAIG

AUTHORIZING MISCELLANEOUS APPROPRIATIONS FOR F/Y 1994-95

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance and is not of a general and permanent nature and shall not become part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.


Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA that the office of the City Administrator is hereby authorized to receive, negotiate, execute and administer any and all documents and contracts required for granting funds to the City of Craig and managing funds on behalf of this entity. The City Administrator is also authorized to execute any subsequent amendments to said contracts to provide for adjustments to the projects within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the need of the project. An further, that the amount of these grants be appropriated to the office of the City Administrator for expenditure of these projects. The projects are listed below.


- 1) \$1,500,000 from Alaska Municipal Bond Bank for design and construction of the Craig Municipal Swimming Pool
- 2) \$20,000 from DCRA, Mini Grant Program, for property development of the Marine Industrial Park
- 3) \$7,400 from Alaska Department of Corrections for Safety/Security Equipment at the Community Jail
