ORDINANCE NO. 446

**AMENDING 9.62.040 BY CHANGING IT TO CRIMINAL MISCHIEF IN THE THIRD DEGREE WITH A DAMAGE AMOUNT OF LESS THAN \$500.00 AND TO ADD SECTION 9.62.045 CRIMINAL MISCHIEF IN THE FOURTH DEGREE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Action. Section 9.62.040 is amended by deleting those words that are capitalized and in brackets and adding those words that are underlined and by adding section 9.62.045 as follows:

**9.62.040** Criminal mischief in the [FOURTH DEGREE] third degree. A person commits the crime of criminal mischief in the [FOURTH DEGREE] third degree if, having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe the person has such a right:

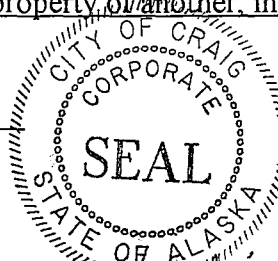
A. [WITH INTENT TO DAMAGE PROPERTY OF ANOTHER] the person recklessly damages property of another in an amount less than [FIFTY DOLLARS] five hundred dollars;

B. The person tampers with a fire protection [DEVISE] device in a building that is a public place.

**9.62.045** Criminal mischief in the fourth degree. A person commits the crime of criminal mischief in the fourth degree if, having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe the person has such a right:

A. The person recklessly damages property of another, in an amount less than fifty dollars.
