CITY OF CRAIG ORDINANCE NO. 454

AMENDING TITLE 4 .20.040 BY ELIMINATING THE 10% DISCOUNT FOR THOSE PAYING THEIR ANNUAL PERMANENT MOORAGE FEES BY THE 20TH OF THE MONTH DUE OR PAYING ONE YEAR OF TRANSIENT MOORAGE FEES IN ADVANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

- Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.
- Section 2. <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- Section 3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
- Section 4. <u>Action.</u> This ordinance amends 4.20.040 of the Craig Municipal Code by deleting those words that are capitalized and in brackets as follows:
- A. All reserved permanent moorage payments are due and payable in advance. Fees for reserved permanent moorage that become sixty days past due will result in the forfeiture of the reserved slip. [A TEN PERCENT DISCOUNT SHALL BE GIVEN THOSE PAYING ANNUAL MOORAGE FEES BY THE TWENTIETH OF THE MONTH DUE]. A slip that is assigned for over one half of the month shall be considered as one full month for the purposes of fees due.

C. Moorage payments for vessels, at the three month or six month rates shall be paid in advance. [A TEN PERCENT DISCOUNT SHALL BE GIMEN THOSE PAYING FOR ONE YEAR OF TRANSIENT MOORAGE IN ADVANCE]
