## ORDINANCE NO. 477

## CITY OF CRAIG

## AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATIONS OF GRANTS FOR F/Y 1999-2000

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>: This is a non-code ordinance and is not of a general and permanent nature and shall not become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA that the office of the City Administrator is hereby authorized to receive, negotiate, execute and administer any and all documents and contracts required for granting funds to the City of Craig and managing funds on behalf of this entity. The City Administrator is also authorized to execute any subsequent amendments to said contracts to provide for adjustments to the projects within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the need of the project. And further that the amount of these grants be appropriated to the office of the City Administrator for expenditure of these projects. The projects are listed below.

- 1. \$6,450 from DCRA for the ACMP Planning Grant
- 2. \$6,300 from Alaska State Library for Public Library Assistance Grant Program
- 3. \$26,197 from Department of Community and Regional Affairs for Child Care Assistance Program
- 4. \$618,000 from Department of Environmental Conservation for the Construction Facilities Plan for the Wastewater Treatment Plant
- 5. \$50,795 from Department of Administration Capital Project matching grant program for the Design and Construction of the J.T. Brown Industrial Park
- 6. \$50,795 from Department of Administration Capital Project matching grant program for a Community Emergency Response Vehicle & crisis Capacity
- 7. \$350,000 from Alaska Department of Fish & Game for False Island Boat Ramp
