

ORDINANCE NO. 479

CITY OF CRAIG

AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATIONS OF GRANTS FOR F/Y 1999-2000

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance and is not of a general and permanent nature and shall not become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.


Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Action. That the office of the City Administrator is hereby authorized to receive, negotiate, execute and administer any and all documents and contracts required for granting funds to the City of Craig and managing funds on behalf of this entity. The City Administrator is also authorized to execute any subsequent amendments to said contracts to provide for adjustments to the projects within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the need of the project. And that the amount of these grants be appropriated to the office of the City Administrator for expenditure of these projects. The projects are listed below.

1. \$150,000 from United States Dept. of Agriculture for design and construction of the J.T. Brown Marine Industrial Park.
2. \$ 50,000 from Unites States Dept. of Agriculture for a feasibility study on a dry Kiln at the J.T. Brown Marine Industrial Park.
