ORDINANCE NO. 483

AMENDING TITLE 4, BOAT HARBOR, OF THE CRAIG MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted hereby shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective May 1, 2000.

Section 4. Action. This ordinance amends sections of Title 4, Boat Harbor, of the Craig Municipal Code by adding those words that are underlined and bolded and by deleting those words that are capitalized and in brackets, by moving B. of 4.30.140 and placing it under section 4.30.130 I. and by adding a new section 4.30.180, Use of launch ramps, as follows:

- 4.10.020 Definitions. G. "Residence" means a vessel which serves as sleeping quarters for its owner(s) or occupants(s) for [MORE THAN ONE-HALF OF ANY SIX-DAY] fifteen (15) days or more per thirty-day period.
- 4.20.010 Transactions to be conducted at Harbor Office or City Hall. All registration of boats, payment of moorage charges and other harbor facility business will be conducted at the harbor office or city hall.
- 4.30.140 Prohibited Acts. B. [TYING OR MOORING PILE DRIVERS, SCOWS, BARGES, BOATHOUSES, OR OTHER SIMILAR VESSELS, OR VESSELS OVER ONE HUNDRED FEET IN LENGTH, TO ANY FLOAT;] (this B. spot will be left blank)
- 4.30.130 Acts prohibited without prior approval of the harbormaster. I. Tying or mooring pile drivers, scows, barges, boathouses, or other similar vessels, or vessels over one hundred feet in length, to any float;
- 4.30.140 Prohibited acts. I. Storing personal items or fishing gear on the floats and finger floats. Oily rags, open paints and other combustible and explosive materials must not be stored on docks;

4.30.180 Use of Launch Ramps. Launch ramps shall be open to public use. Access to launch ramps shall be maintained at all times. Staging zones shall be designated and kept open at all times. Mooring of vessels, logs, floats, herring pounds, or other such items are not allowed in the launch ramp staging areas. The council may set, by resolution, fees for the use of the launch ramps.
