ORDINANCE NO. 495

CHANGING THE IMPOUNDMENT PROCEDURE 7.04.030 AND CHANGING THE TIME WHEN THE CITY CAN DISPOSE OF IMPOUNDED ANIMALS 7.04.060

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Action. This ordinance amends 7.04.030 Impoundment Procedure and 7.04.060 Disposal of impounded animals by adding those words that are underlined and bolded and by deleting those words that are capitalized and in brackets.

7.04.030 Impoundment procedure. B. When the impounded animal is a dog:

1. If the dog is licensed, the animal control officer or chief of police shall forthwith give notice by mail or telephone (if owner is within the city limits) to the owner of such licensed dog, informing the owner of the impoundment and the reason therefor.

2. If the impounded animal is a dog not bearing a license tag, the animal control officer or chief of police shall give notice within twenty-four hours of such impoundment by posting notice at police headquarters [AND SUCH OTHER PUBLIC PLACE AS MAY BE PROVIDED FOR SUCH NOTICES.] Such notice shall give the impounded dog, together with the date and location the animal was apprehended, [AND THE DATE THE ANIMAL WILL BE DISPOSED OF AS PROVIDED IN THIS CHAPTER IF NOT EARLIER REDEEMED.]

7.04.040 Disposal of impounded animals. Any animal which has been impounded may be redeemed during the first three days thereafter by any person claiming to own, or act for the owner of, the animal, upon payment of the fees and costs as set forth in Section 7.04.050. After the first **24 hours** [THREE DAYS], the animal may be redeemed by any person, upon payment of the fees and costs as set forth in Section 7.04.050 above. If an impounded animal has not been redeemed within [FIVE DAYS] **24 hours** after being impounded, such animal shall be subject to disposal by the city by any of the following means:
