## ORDINANCE NO. 507

## AMENDING CHAPTER 2.12.060 OF THE CRAIG MUNICIPAL CODE OF ELECTIONS, CANDIDATES QUALIFICATIONS AND CHAPTER 2.12.080, CHANGING THE LENGTH OF TIME CANDIDATES CAN FILE FOR OFFICE

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. <u>Action.</u> This ordinance amends Chapter 2.12, Municipal Elections, of the Craig Municipal code, sections 2.12.060 and 2.12.080, by adding those words that are bolded and underlined and deleting those words that are capitalized and in brackets.

<u>2.12.060 Candidates qualifications.</u> A) A qualified elector who shall have resided continuously in the city during the thirty days immediately preceding the election may be <u>a candidate</u> [NOMINATED] for an elective city office.

B) A person may be <u>a candidate</u> [NOMINATED] for more than one office, but he may not serve simultaneously as mayor and as a councilman.

<u>2.12.080 Time for filing for office</u>. A declaration of candidacy shall be filed at the city clerk's office not earlier than sixty days nor later than <u>thirty-two</u> [THIRTY] days before the election.
