ORDINANCE NO. 591

AMENDING C.M.C. 3.04.060, RIGHT OF PROTEST, BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. <u>Action.</u> This ordinance amends 3.04.060 A. by adding those words that are bolded and underlined, and deleting those words that are in brackets[].

A. Owners of taxed property shall have the right to protest, before the board of equalization, the assessed value established on their properties. Protests shall be submitted to the city clerk or treasurer in writing <u>thirty days from the date the notice of assessment is mailed to the property owner.</u> [at least seven days prior to the scheduled meeting of the board of equalization].
