CITY OF CRAIG ORDINANCE NO. 603

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 8, CRAIG MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 8.10.120 REGARDING CLEARING LITTER FROM PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY BY MUNICIPALITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG, ALASKA:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted hereby shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application of other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. <u>Action</u>. This ordinance amends Section 8.10.120 of the Craig Municipal Code by deleting the items shown with strikethrough text and surrounded by square brackets ([strikethrough]) and by adding the underlined items, as follows:

8.10.120 Clearing Litter from public or private property by municipality
A. Notice to Remove. The mayor or the mayor's designee is authorized and empowered to notify the owner of any private property within the municipality or the agent of the owner to properly dispose of litter located on public property or on the owner's property. The notice shall be <u>served</u> by [registered mail] certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to the owner or agent at his last known address, or by hand-delivery to the <u>owner or agent of the owner</u>. If the owner is not known or the notice is returned because of inability to make delivery thereof, notice of the intended removal shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the city.
