ORDINANCE NO. 604

AMENDING CHAPTER 7.04 BY ADDING SECTION 7.04.025 REMOVAL OF ANIMAL EXCRETA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

- Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.
- Section 2. <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- Section 3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Action. This ordinance adds those words that are underlined and bolded:

Section 7.04.025 Removal of Animal Excreta The owner of any animal shall be responsible for the immediate removal of any excreta deposited by his or her animal on public streets, sidewalks, harbor floats or walkways, City parks, recreation areas, or private property other than his own. (The definition of Excreta-faeces, fecal matter, feces, discharged from the animal's body.) Penalties CMC 7.01.020.
