ORDINANCE NO. 623

ESTABLISHING A TIME WHEN THE NEWLY ELECTED OFFICIAL TAKES HIS SEAT ON THE COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

- Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.
- Section 2. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- Section 3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
- Section 4. <u>Action.</u> This ordinance adds section 2.12.365 to the Craig Municipal Code by adding the underlined wording as follows: <u>Seating of a newly elected official</u>

A newly elected official shall be seated when the regular term of office begins on the first Monday following certification of the election, or at the first city council meeting following certification of the election, which ever comes first.
