ORDINANCE NO. 640

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 15.12. APPLICATION FOR SEWER SERVICE-15.12.030-DEPOSITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRAIG:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the code sections adopted shall become a part of the code of the City of Craig, Alaska.

Section 2. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. <u>Action.</u> This ordinance deletes those words that are in brackets with strikethrough text and adds those words that are underlined and bolded, as follows:

At the time the deposit is given, the applicant will be given a receipt for the same. The deposit is not to be considered as a payment on account. In the event that water service is discontinued as provided in CMC 15.16.040 through 15.16.070, the deposit will be applied to the total amount due for sewer and water service and any amount in excess of the total amount due will be refunded. [The city will pay a reasonable rate of interest on deposits, the rate to be determined by resolution of the council.]

<u>If account is in good standing after one year, the deposit will be applied to current balances.</u>
