

The Department of Transportation and Public Facilities(DOT/PF) is proposing to construct a new seaplane base in Craig. DOT/PF proposes situating the base's terminal building on a portion of Tract C-T, USS 1429. This is land currently owned by Henry and Darlene Ford and DOT/PF is in the process of acquiring land for the project.

This project will include the extension of water and sewer improvements to the terminal's building. The improvements will include installation of a fire hydrant to serve both the terminal building and the Ford's Marina. The Alaska Legislature appropriated funding for this project in 1992. The appropriated amount is sufficient to construct all the improvements to the subdivision. DOT&PF intends to advertise for bids and award a contract to construct this project this fall and to have all improvements completed by the fall of 1995.

Please accept this letter as assurance that the required water and sewer improvements for the subdivision will be constructed as outlined above, in lieu of a cash bond.
