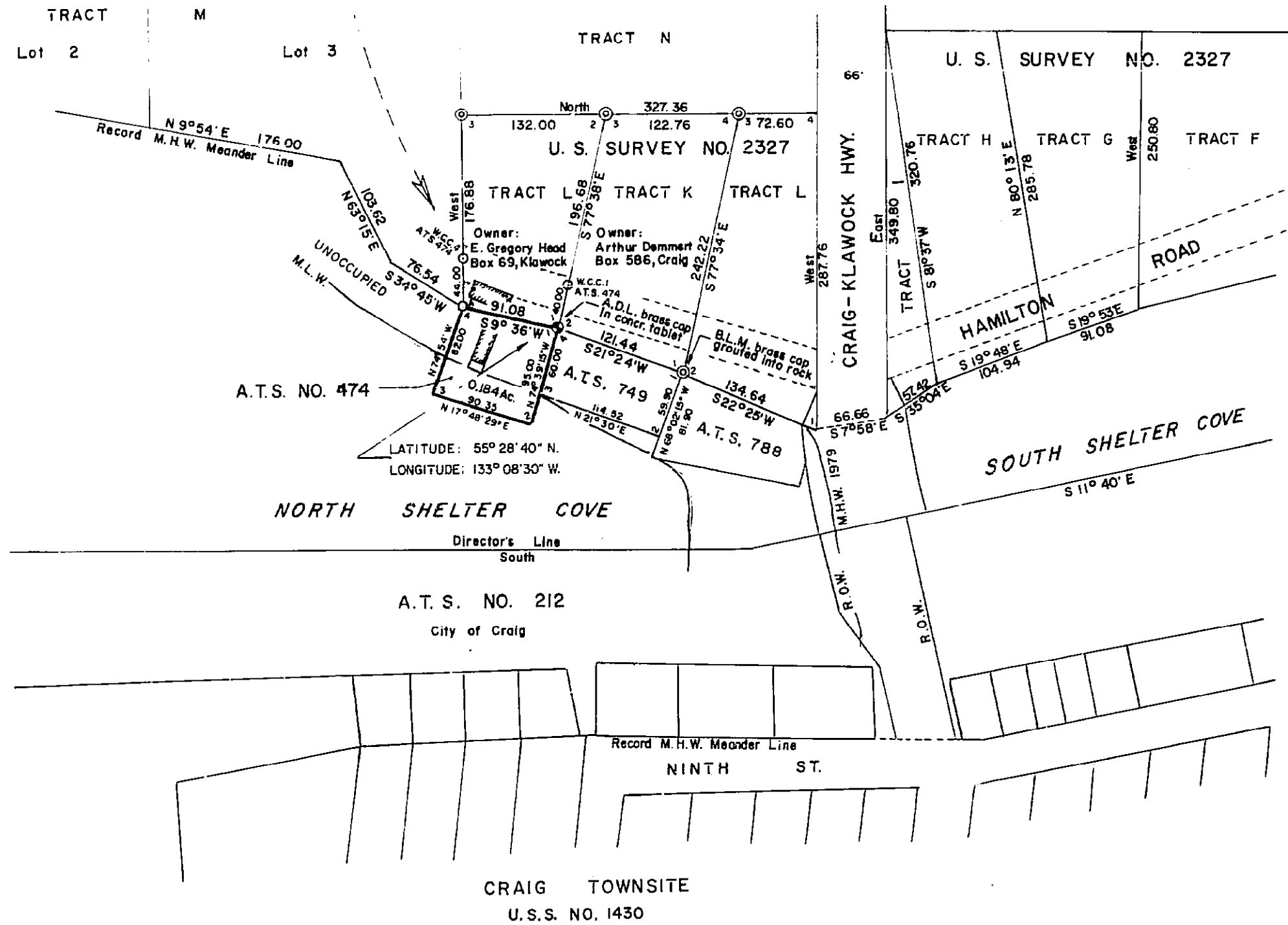
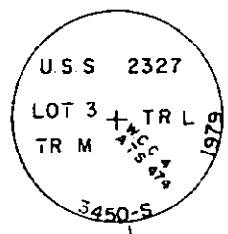

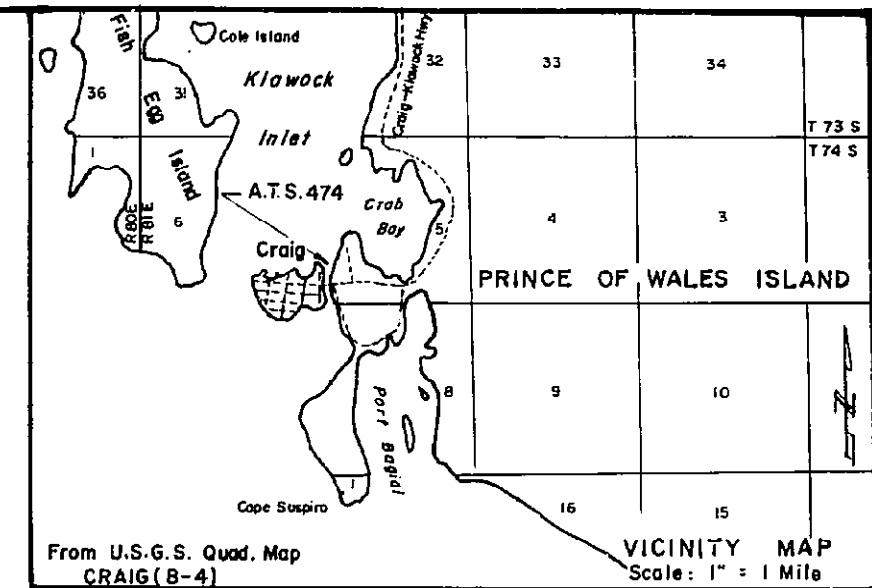


**DESCRIPTION OF ALASKA TIDELAND SURVEY NO. 474:**

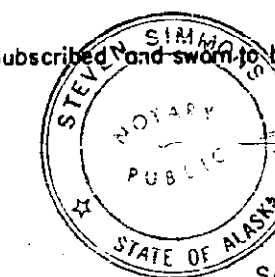

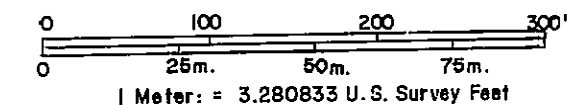
