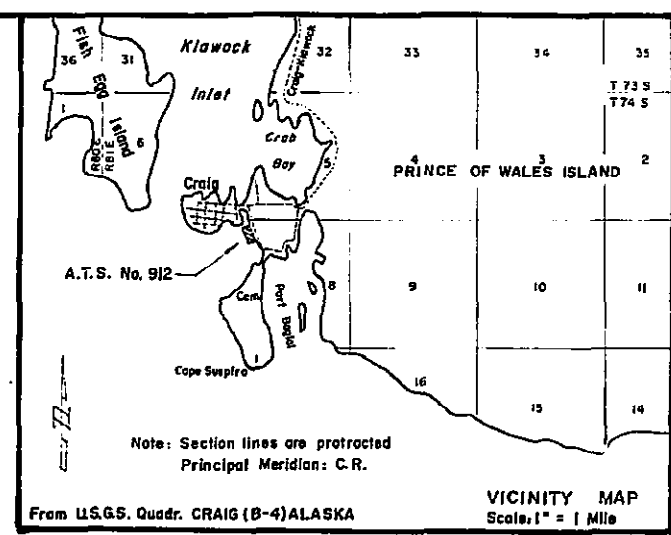
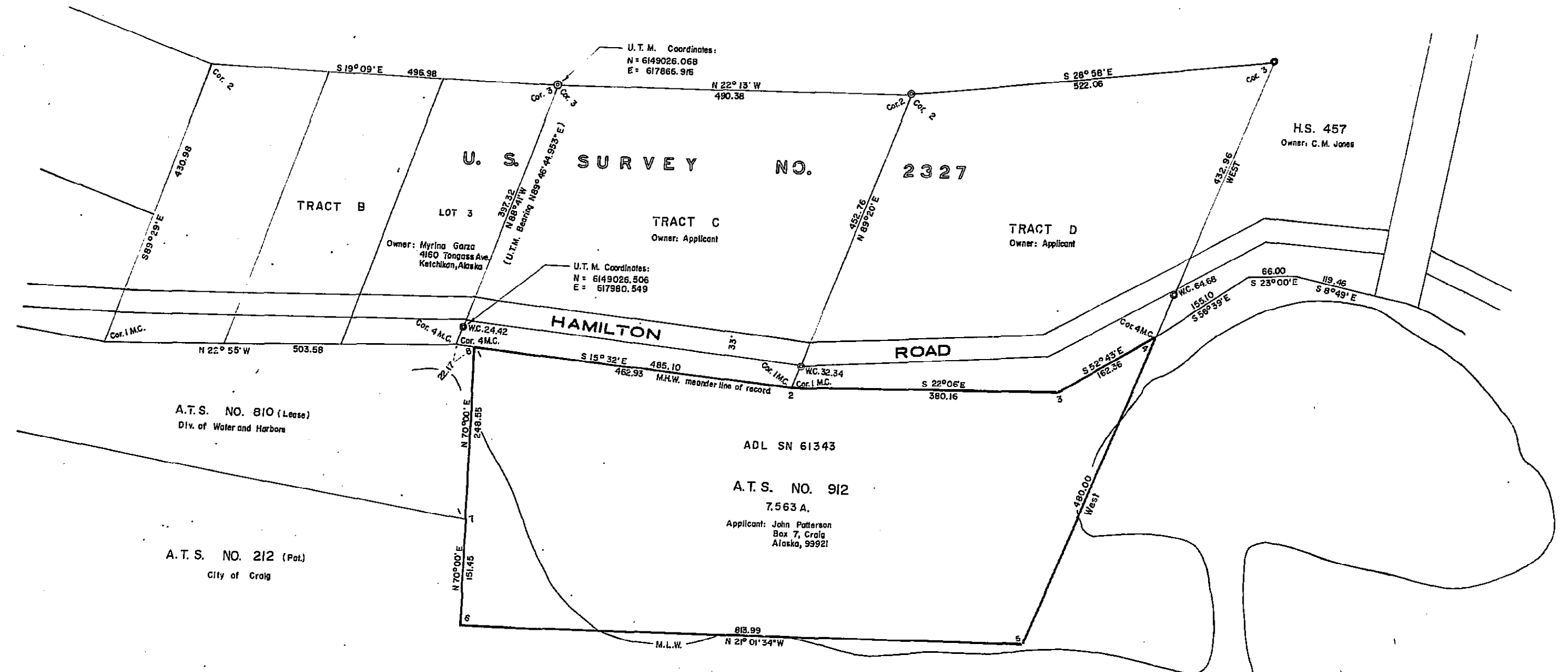

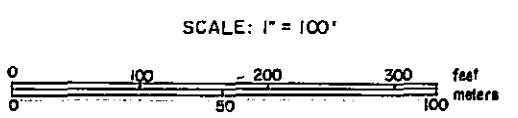
DESCRIPTION OF ALASKA TIDELANDS SURVEY NO. 912:
(Within Pratr. Sect. 8, T 74 S, R 8 E, C. R. M.)

Beginning at W.C.M.C. 4 of Tract C, U.S. Survey No. 2327, a point monumented with a standard B.L.M. brass cap, thence N 88° 41' W 24.42 ft. to Cor. 4 M.C. of said Tract C, thence along the mean high water meander line of said Tract C S 15° 32' E 22.17 ft. to Cor. No. 1 of A.T.S. No. 912, identical to Cor. No. 8 of A.T.S. No. 810, at Longitude 55° 28' 30" N. and Longitude 135° 08' W. From Cor. No. 1 of A.T.S. No. 912, by metes and bounds,
S 15° 32' E along the meanders of record of U.S. Survey No. 2327 a distance of 462.95 ft. to Cor. No. 2, thence S 22° 06' E 380.16 ft. to Cor. No. 3, thence S 52° 43' E 162.36 ft. to Cor.
