Dear Tom,

Thanks for your quick action regarding the culvert that was placed in the stream on the temporary road at the industrial park. Mark Minillo and I took a look at the pipe that had been initially placed and the larger pipe that was later placed.

Since the road was constructed (or reconstructed) as part of the project permitted under building permit 11-08 I will add the temporary road to the building permit. However, the stream crossing does require US Army Corps of Engineer approval, or a jurisdictional determination that the project is not within the scope of the Corps' jurisdiction. Since the work has already been done the permit will have to be prepared as an "after the fact" permit.

Please contact the US Army Corps of Engineers Regulatory Branch to work out the permit process with them. They may also require that you complete a Coastal Project Questionnaire under the Alaska Coastal Management Program, which would include a review by the Office of Habitat Management and Permitting (Mr. Minillo). I will include the requirement for a US Army Corps of Engineers permit or determination (after the fact) as special condition number two on the building permit.

If the primary construction site was never permitted, or if the scope of development is different from the original permitting you may also want to include the development parcel in the permit request.
